Following an analytical overview (toward building consensus around a shared understanding of a particular global problem-set and analyzing and critiquing the status quo response), debate and elaborate on at least one (and not more than two) "Our Common Agenda" reform proposals and one (and not more than two) ideas beyond "Our Common Agenda" in response to particular global problem-sets and related gaps in global governance – whether of an institutional, legal, policy, normative, or operational nature.

Lead Off Questions for Participants:

• How might we understand the problem (and related opportunities) at hand in relation to the subject matter? Which actors can we identify as key spoilers in today's global context, and what key trends can be identified as challenges towards promoting greater international engagement in the focus area of your Breakthrough Group?

- How might we build on, and further flesh out ONE (and no more than two) recommendation identified in the "Our Common Agenda" pertaining to the subject matter, and what strategy/actions need to be pursued to achieve the suggested proposals in the coming years, including in advance of the 2023 Summit of the Future and 2025 Social Summit?
- What's missing from the wider UN Agenda surrounding your Breakthrough Group's subject focus, and what further actions need to be taken beyond the OCA and 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development? Who are the key stakeholders in this process?
- What are the key elements of a "strategy for reform" to have your idea(s) seriously considered during the Pact for the Future negotiations (or related strategic frameworks, such as the new Agenda for Peace, Declaration on Future Generations, and Global Digital Compact) in the run-up to the September 2023 Summit of the Future?
